4 Paws for Ability is a non profit agency that places service dogs with children and veterans with special needs. 4 Paws utilizes volunteers to work with our service dogs in training. These volunteers are considered puppy raisers and volunteer trainers because they have been evaluated and trained to participate in our program. The service dogs in training are primarily: Labs, Golden Retrievers, Papillons or mixes of these breeds. Service dogs in training are traditionally in the age range of 8 weeks to 2 years old.

It is the responsibility of the puppy raiser to make sure that the service dog in training is safely confined in the kennel when not able to be supervised. When out of the kennel the service dog in training must be supervised both inside the home and outside. The service dog in training must remain on leash at all times when not in a confined area and will be wearing a 4 Paws vest when in public places. The puppy raiser is responsible for cleaning up after the service dog in training both inside the home and in the yard. Puppy raisers are trained to be respectful to the environment that they live and would be responsible in the event that any damage may occur.
